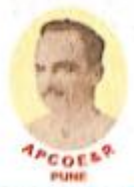

In curricular activities such as practical batches, girl students are equally distributed and given freedom to get accommodated in batches as per their choice. Students choose their own project group



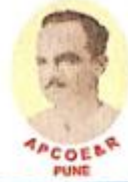

(b) Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats of the total seats for Maharashtra candidates coming under CAP per course shall be reserved for Children of ex- service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1), Children of active service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2), Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State, or who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC examination from a school/college situated in the State of Maharashtra.

- These seats are within the sanctioned intake and are available as **State Level seats**.
- A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 and DEF3 candidates shall be prepared.
- Candidates claiming these seats shall produce additional documents in Proforma C, D and/or E as applicable.
- This provision is NOT available to the children of **CIVILIAN STAFF** who is working /who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

(c) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Five percent (5%) seats of total seats for Maharashtra candidates per course coming under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates having any of the following minimum 40% benchmark disability.

A single merit list of all eligible candidates shall be prepared. The allotment of seats reserved for the Candidates with Disability shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit. **These seats are available for Maharashtra domiciled candidates in HU / SL seats.**

The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates from the authority competent for issuing such certificate. The certificate (Pro-forma) should clearly state that the extent of disability is not less than 40% (Forty percent) and the disability is permanent in nature.

Note: -

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities.

- (d) **Reservation for EWS Candidate:** As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो -4019/प्र.क्र.31/16-अ, dated 1st February, 2019 and सामान्य प्रशासन विभाग, शासन निर्णय क्र. राआधो/४०१९ प्र.क्र.३१/१६ अ, dated 31.05.2021, 10% seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time. These 10% seats shall be over & above the sanctioned intake for the respective course.
- (e) **Reservations for Orphan Candidates** - One percent (1%) seats of CAP Seats (excluding Minority institutions, All India Seats, if any) shall be reserved for Orphan Candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per Government Resolution, Women and Child Welfare Department, No. AMJ-2011/C.R. 212 / Desk 3 dated 2nd April 2018 and the policies of the Government declared from time to time.
- (f) **Reservation for female candidates:** As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. GEC-1000/ (123/2000)/ Tech. Edu.-1, dated 17th April, 2000, 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates. There shall be no reservation for Female candidates under Defence, Persons with Disability and Orphan categories.

Taekwondo workshop was organized by ANANTRAO PAWAR COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING & RESEARCH in association with Savitribai Phule Pune University. The program was conducted on 12 January 2019 in the campus of APCOER, Pune.

The guest for the program was Mr. Pankaj Chikalthankar, Mr. Nikhil Walunj and Mr. Pankaj Gupchup, working as an taekwondo instructor since last 8 years in Bhosale taekwondo academy. With presence of these three eminent personalities, Prof. Ganesh Kondhalkar, (SWO, APCOER, PUNE) inaugurated the program on 9.15 a.m. Welcome speech given by Prof. Snehal Veer. Total 90 students from ANANTRAO PAWAR COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING & RESEARCH attended this program. All students and guests were provided breakfast on 10.15 a.m. and the first session started at 10.30 a.m. The entire TAEKWONDO program was based on creating awareness about grievances, self defense. Mr. Nikhil Walunj and his trainer conducted the first session from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. During this session they focused on self-defense using kicks and punches. They need a source of power that will carry them through life with humility and with proof of success built into their future.

All the students and guests were provided lunch at 1.30 p.m. and the next session started on 2.20 p.m. In the second session, Girls students participated and also performed TAEKWONDO with a lot of enthusiasm and curiosity. At the end of the program, the valedictory function was organized. Mr. Nikhil Walunj and Professor Ganesh Kondhalkar distribute certificates. Valedictory speech given by Prof. Vaishali Bhimte, she extended heartfelt gratitude and thanks to all guests, our students and supporting faculty members. Students gave their feedback about the program. The program was well structured and conducted in a live and interactive session.
