Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at 2.30 p.m on 04/09/2017 Monday.

BETWEEN

Global Talent Track Private Limited a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, having its Registered Office at 401, 4th Floor, Zero One IT Park, Ghorpadi- Mundhwa Road, Mundhwa, Pune-411036, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as "**GTT**" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators, executors and assignees) of the **First Part**.

AND

Anantrao Pawar College Of engineering & Research Parvati Pune located at Sr.No 103/Parvati Pune 411009 hereinafter referred to as " " (Which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the **Second Part**,

WHEREAS:

1. GTT is a Training Partner associated with various corporates for providing training to the students as part of their CSR activity.
2. Anantrao Pawar College Of engineering & Research Parvati Pune College is an Educational institution affiliated to SPPU University. The College offers various Graduate & Post Graduate Courses in APCOER.
3. APCOER College is willing to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with GTT for the skills enhancement initiative through Career Clap, the technology platform and other face to face initiatives.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

1. Objective:

The objective of this MOU is to enable students of APCOER_College access resources that would enhance their employability.

2. Period of MOU:

This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of One year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

3. Roles & Responsibilities of the College:

- a. The College shall be responsible to nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the engagement. The person so appointed would act as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the proposed initiative.
- b. The College shall share the details of the students like name, email ID, contact details who are willing to undergo the aforesaid skill enhancement initiative through Career Clap with GTT in the College Letterhead. The College further authorises GTT to share the above information with NASSCOM Foundation/ Barclays to get in touch with the students for updating them about various job fairs, placement drives etc, and to seek feedback of the program.
- c. It would be the responsibility of the College to ensure that proper publicity of the Program is made through College website.
- d. To encourage the Students to register for the Program by informing them about the benefits of the program.
- e. To provide all the support services and facilities to **GTT** during the conduct of the said Training Program.

- f. To coordinate with GTT and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by GTT, as per schedule communicated by GTT.

4. Roles & Responsibilities of GTT:

- a. GTT shall be responsible to provide access to employability enhancement related activities through blended learning model including use of Career Clap.
- b. GTT will arrange for assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.

5. Other Terms & Conditions:

Following are the other terms and conditions of MOU:

- a. The students enrolled should complete the training as scheduled.
- b. The students should register online through Career Clap and appear for Assessments as required.
- c. Program Coordinator to be appointed by college
- d. TPO's active support and participation is required for smooth & efficient conduct of the program
- e. The College shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of GTT/ Nasscom Foundation/ Barclays in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from GTT.

6. Commercial:

This Training Program is free of cost. GTT shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or the College for conducting the aforesaid training program.

7. Certification:

E-Certificates shall be awarded by GTT to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the training program.

8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

9. Termination:

- a. Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- b. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

10. Entirety & Amendment:

This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU. Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

11. Intellectual Proprietary Rights:

All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.

12. Confidential Information:

- a. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is inconsequential or obvious;
- b. Already in its possession other than as a result of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than as a result of a breach of this clause.
- c. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party so as to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.
- d. Both parties agree not to deal directly or enter into any business agreement with any of the partners or associates or customers of either party during the term of the agreement and also after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

13. Force Majeure:

- a. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be

result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.

- b. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.

14. Jurisdiction and Arbitration:

- a. In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Pune alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Pune, Maharashtra.
- b. Any dispute arising out of, in relation to or in respect to this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MOU. In case a settlement is not arrived at within fifteen (15) days of reference, the dispute/s shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The place of arbitration shall be Pune, India.

Following points were discussed and agreed between two parties for Industry Institute Interaction for mutual benefits.

1.0 Focus Area

Party A will help to assist to **Party B** for the following activities.

1. Help to develop Center of Excellence in related areas.
2. Conduct workshop on various skills development of students.
3. Industry visits for faculty and students
4. Guest lecture on recent trends in industry by deputing experts.
5. Assisting final year students for their project work.
6. Providing Internship program.
7. Campus interview as and when required.
8. Conduct of Value-Add or Certification programs for students.
9. Providing training to the faculty and students.
10. Participation in syllabus revision.

Party B will help to assist to **Party A** for following activities.

1. Testing of materials
2. Provide assistance to upgrade the qualification of employee.
3. Special software training.
4. Sharing library and laboratory facilities.

5. Display of newly developed products.
6. Provide consultancy through Center of Excellence in the concern department.

Now therefore, in consideration of the premises and the actual covenants herein contained, it is agreed by both **Party A** and **Party B** as under.

2.0 Definitions and Interpretation

Following Memorandum of Understanding has been executed between and signed by the above mentioned two parties.

1. Party A will provide the full support to develop the Center of Excellence in related areas.
2. Party A will permit their executives and experts to render their expertise for the academic benefits of the students of Party B, through invited lectures, seminar, workshop as judges to various technical competition etc., in a convenient manner.
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3.0 Responsibility Structure

1. **Party B** shall provide the infrastructure of systems, LCD projector etc. for the Expert Lectures. Also, the labs and other research equipment available in the lab.
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4.0 Certification

Upon completion of the Internship, **Party A & Party B** will jointly conduct technical assessment for students. The students qualifying the technical assessment shall be certified with completion certificate.

5.0 Relationship

This MOU relates solely to the intention of the parties, wherein **Party B** and **Party A** jointly work together and shall not extend to any other activity or create a partnership between the Parties hereto and under any law of any country. The parties agree that it is not their intention to share any loss or profit between them in their respective fields, except to the extent expressly provided herein.

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Three year from the date of signing of MOU, unless renewed on a mutually agreed terms and condition for a further period. During the initial term or any renewal term, either party may terminate this MOU, after mutually agreed days, with prior written notice to the other party.

7.0 Consequential Damages

Other than explicitly mentioned in this MOU, either Party shall not under any circumstances or at any time be liable to the other under or in connection with the MOU for any special or any direct or indirect loss or damage or for any consequential loss or damage, whether direct or indirect, including but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, loss of profits, loss of production, or loss of opportunities.

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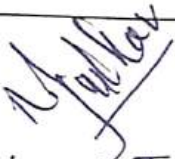
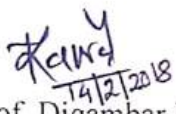
