



Paper Submission Guidelines

1. Prospective authors are encouraged to submit full papers (minimum 6 pages) for review. Only original papers that have not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere will be considered.
2. Accepted papers will be assigned to a regular technical session.
3. All papers will go through a rigorous, single-blind reviewing process. At least one author of an accepted paper will have to register at the conference (full registration required) in order to submit the final version.
4. Once reviewed the listing of authors connected to the paper can NOT be changed in the final manuscript.
5. Papers should be written in English with a maximum paper length of 8 (full paper) printed pages IEEE format (10-point font) including figures. The conference maintains the right to refrain from reviewing papers that are longer than 8 pages.
6. For your submission, you can use the standard IEEE conference templates for Microsoft Word or LaTeX formats found at: <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>
7. The format for the manuscript must satisfy the following requirements:
 - The manuscript must be in English.
 - The manuscript must follow IEEE two-column format with single-spaced, ten-point font in the text.
 - The maximum manuscript length is six (6) pages. All figures, tables, references, etc. are included in the page limit.
 - Papers must be submitted in Portable Document Format (PDF) as well as Word format.
